Mission Statement for the Valley River Arts Guild

The Valley River Arts Guild, formed in 2010, supports the talent and creativity of the artists in our community, unifies our community around the arts through classes and events, and enhances the livability of our town as an art-centric community.

Seeing an incredible opportunity and taking a massive leap of faith, the Valley River Arts Guild put together every bit of our resources to purchase 12 Peachtree Street to become the new home of the Murphy Art Center, giving us more space for our community programs and more security in the ownership of our own home. We will need the help of the community to keep us here so we can continue to produce and expand all of our art programs!

What does the Valley River Arts Guild do?

- -We provide the community with a beautiful gallery of fine arts and local crafts of all types, open every day, run by the artist members themselves with no paid staff. Our co-op art Guild nurtures and supports new and emerging artists and crafters to excel, showcase and sell their art in this beautiful venue.
- -The Art Guild produces the monthly *First Friday Art Walk* for the benefit and enjoyment of the community, local and regional artists and musicians without charge to show their art or attend the festival. Our volunteers do all of the legwork for merchant relations, advertising, highway sign distribution, grant-writing, brochures and ad design, and event permits.
- -Our Guild volunteers created a wonderful *Kids Art Classes Program* of Saturday classes, workshops, and art experiences, offering free to low-cost art classes for the community's children.
- -We offer weekly classes in a variety of *arts and crafts for adults and teens* at very reasonable prices, all held in a designated classroom space for the benefit of the community.
- -The Art Guild created and installs the *Outdoor Art Gallery's* big 5 foot canvas art panels for *the MAX Project: Murphy Art Xplosion* throughout downtown Murphy, to help create an art destination for the region by bringing the community together to discover and view the art. With community outreach, we discover hidden-gem artists who have never before had their artwork seen in public, giving recognition and support to many local and regional artists.

- -Our hopes are to expand our artist membership by providing a larger gallery space to showcase more varieties of arts and crafts at the new *Murphy Art Center* for the benefit of the artists and the public.

- -We hope to expand the MAX Project, Murphy Art Xplosion, to install more art panels throughout downtown, to hold juried shows, foster friendly competitions, and continue to change out the art in seasonal displays for the delight and enjoyment of the public and the support of many more regional artists.
